

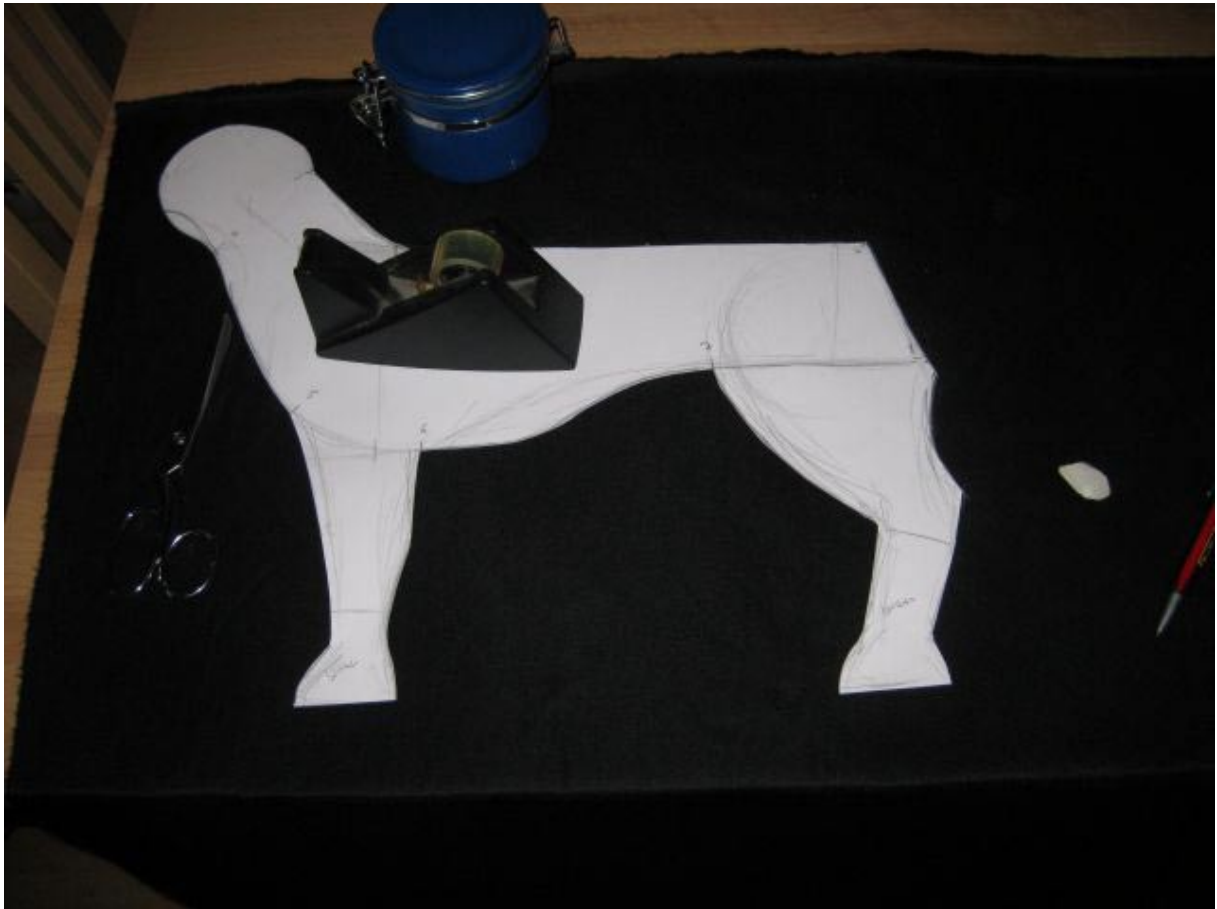
## How to build (not breed) a Lancashire Heeler :-)

First of all, you have to measure your Heeler. Ignore the rebellion, it is for a good cause.

If you have successful measured your Heeler (and he/she is still talking to you and all your fingers are still on your hand), you can start to draw a paper pattern.



Put the pattern on to a piece of plush, mark them with tailors chalk and cut them out (the colour of the plush should be similar to your Heeler, unless you`re dreaming of a green and blue Heeler ;-)



If you are a good Tailor, the result of your work should look like this. Otherwise: don't panic, try it once again. No-one is born a master.



Now you have to put together all the pieces of plush. Again take a look at your Heeler, just to be sure that everything is in the right order. Looks good? Okay, now start sewing (don't forget to buy some medical strips for your fingers)



Stow the plush-Heeler with cotton. A view minutes later, the plush Heeler should look like this



Now feed and walk your real Heeler. Just to keep him/her happy. All done? Okay, let's go on: Put ears and nose to the head. Looks good? Super! Now look your real Heeler straight in the eyes. Keep in mind where exactly the eyes of your Heeler are and baste the glass eyes on the plush Heeler.



All cotton is in the plush Heeler and all seams are closed? You are a fantastic Craftsman. Be proud of your work and take some funny pictures of your real Heeler and his/her lookalike
