1 Coleman and Flanagan's Adnyl Black Excess at Jazeeler. Good markings and colour moved well for age of only 9 months but would like to see it carrying a little more weight. **BPD**

1 St Clair Pearce's Traqdean Flowin Micky. Nice head and in proportion with body did manage to show of its ears in the end, good set of teeth. Well marked and moved well from the rear.

PGD (5)

1 Mrs N Rice's Bowanne Licorice Lace. Well made sound dog of just over 4 years, moved well with balance would have liked markings to be more conformed.

2 Mr & Mrs Gaters Colnestar Voules Vous. A younger dog than one but still as sound better head than one with good shaped dark eyes but lost it on the movement and teeth.

3 Mrs Spooners Audaxus Blue Moon.

1 Mrs Bancrofts Doddsline Duffy. A dog of only 3 years good all round, head with dark eye and nice ear carriage clear markings to correct neck good top line and rear end, moved well front and back. **RCC**

2 Mrs Spooners Audaxus Blue Monday. Clean lines on this dog dark tan markings shorter than one, not as firm in the body as I would have like but moved well.

3 Bins & Critchlow Black Diamond.

OD (5) 1A

1 Mr & Mrs J Swann's CH Swanndale Man in Black. Good head with strong features good eye shape clean teeth with good bite, clear markings sound and firm body with top line and all followed up with good movement. This dog has the lot. **CC**

2 Cartledge & Lord's Foxthyme Oliver Cromwell SHCM. L/Tan 4 year old dog slightly long in the head but made up for that with soundness and all-round movement. And he looked like he was enjoying his day out.

3 Mrs Bancrofts Doddsline Buscuits by Cheinban.

VD (4)1a

1 Miss J Reids Doddsline Sparkey. At over 10 years is still looking good and still fit, good head and ear carriage dark eye, teeth could have been better. Sound well covered body good movement on rear.

2 Mr & Mrs W Simpsons Mongrel's Uncle-Unwin at Simonsville. Younger dog than one but good clean lines and markings lost to number one on front end movement even with those nice tight feet.

3 Smith & Hucks Doddsline Crafty Lad at Leyeside.

1 Pat Taylors Ronleydon Amber Sunshine Over Tapatina. I liked this bitch has the makings of an all round Heeler, and was shown and moved well, only concern was her body length, good coat condition. **BPB+BPIS**

2 Mrs Davies Ronleydon Amber Falls, Litter sister to no one and was just as pulling to the eye as number one but was just smaller, would have liked better ribbing.

3 Bins & Critchlow Black Diamond.

1 Pat Taylors Ronleydon Amber Sunshine Over Tapatina. As per MPB

2 Mrs J Zimans Swanndale Black Nacissor of Fargaze. Small than one but all in proportion good teeth dark eye good front end with sound rear end this showed in its movement. Needs some training time from handler!.

1 Mr & Mrs W Simpsons Simonsville Briony. Young bitch at 12 months but showing good signs, Soundly built with good coverage of body nice top line, well marked, movement sound all round, found head to be too sharp for my liking.

2 Smith & Hucks Hotpot Sparkle for Leyeside. Old than one shame it did not want to be there, as she is a nice all round bitch head shape good nice body with good legs leading to good tight feet movement again sound.

3 Mr & Mrs Robjohns Traqdean Flowin Martha Over Qwontox.

1 St Clair Pearce's Heelstone Abbi Traqdean. Seen this bitch before and she is maturing nicely. The head on this bitch was all good flat top of skull ears and eye correct and clear sharp markings. Good top line and body size sound tail carriage good and moved with drive.

2 Mr & Mrs W Simpsons, Simonsville Anya May. Just over 2 years had darker head markings than one, had good shape eye and head size leading to a well covered body, lost it on the ribbing but moved with drive and balance front and back.

3 Mr & Mrs Robjohns Traqdean Flowin Martha over Qwontox.

1 Mr & Mrs Gaters Colnesstar Living Doll. Older bitch of 7 years not yet showing its age too much, small head but good sound firm body nice tail carriage on the move and paced well.

2 Taylor & Simpson's, Simonsville Yule Time. Younger than one at just over three years needs to mature as it did not move well shown in good condition and handler worked hard with her.

3 Mrs A Bancroft's Hotpot Kiddie Cate by Cheinban.

1 Mrs E Lords CH Foxthyme Eliza, It was a pleasure to go over this dog as it was handled well and was not held back from showing all the correct standards of a Heeler, I would have liked to have seen a darker eye but could not find any other items to mark down. It was the movement that got it the Best in Show over the dog. **CC + BOB.**

2 Whybrow & St Clair Pearce's CH Traqdean Vidaloca Florence. Older than one so should have been better on the table, it was shown in top condition with nice head top line and sound front end. **RCC**

3 Mr & Mrs Swanns CH Swanndale Black Tulip.
